

## PUPPET

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Herbert L. Dexter, a citizen of the United States, residing at Philadelphia, county of Philadelphia, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Puppet, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof, wherein:

Figure 1 is a perspective view looking at the front of the puppet with the head turned to one side showing my new design;

Figure 2 is a front elevational view of the head and face of the puppet with the mouth in open position; and

Figure 3 is a view on a reduced scale similar to that shown in Figure 2 with the mouth in closed position.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a puppet, as shown.
